FLOWER FESTIVAL: Thanks to the considerable hard work of so many people including the sponsors of flower arrangements the net profit of this event is £1,574.86. This sum includes a significant amount raised by the jams, preserves and pickles stall which had added to this marvellous result.

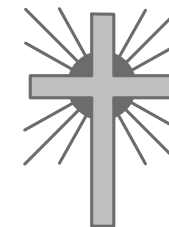
S.PETER'S COLLEGIATE SCHOOL CONCERT: The net profit from the concert was a fantastic sum of £1,886.26 which has broken all records for previous concerts held over the last four years. Half of this sum namely £943.13 is being forwarded to S. Peter's School with the same amount being retained by our church.
