GOOD SHEPHERD RELIEF IN NEED CHARITY: Hello friends at Christ Church. Hello dear friends at Christ Church and Good Shepherd. After the busiest week since we started with 7 family referrals, the last one having 5 children and a burnt out house, we are a bit exhausted but also very grateful. We have just looked at our outputs for the first two quarters of this year and with your support we have helped 99 families to be re-housed across Wolverhampton which in turn meant 46 children having beds who otherwise would be sleeping on the floor. This is a 70 percent increase in giving out year on year. 25 percent of our children in Wolverhampton live in poverty and the total value of second hand costs that we have given away in the last 6 months is £14,566-all given by Christians doing God's work in your home town. Thank you so much on behalf of those recipients. I urgently need hats and gloves for all ages, winter woollies, coats and toys for Christmas.
