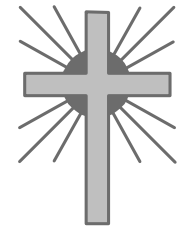

NEWS FROM GOOD SHEPHERD IN RELIEF: Dear Friends at CC & GS. In the last 6 months you have all helped us to completely furnish no less than 99 homes for homeless families and provide 48 beds for children who in the past have had to sleep on the floor and in addition all the items we give each day to social workers, even at our low prices we have given away £16,584. This is a 70% increase on the same period last year. We now need a push for Christmas as we have to find the rent for January so we need warm clothes and shoes for men, women and children.
