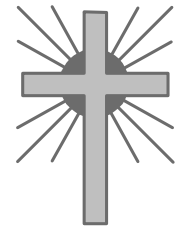
PANCAKE PARTY: following morning service on 23 February at CC. Proceeds to the Bishop's Lent Appeal.
