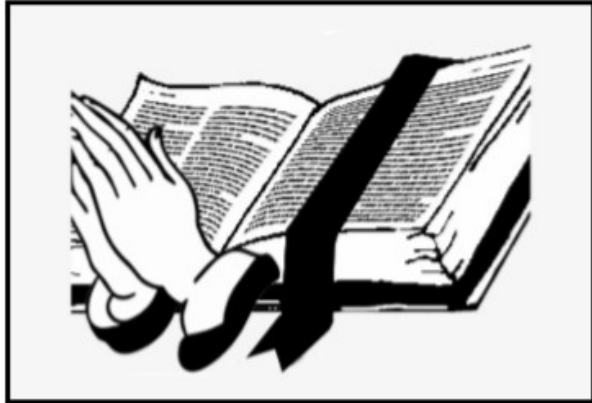


Morning Prayer on a Sunday

The Apostles Creed
