

FAIRTRADE STALLS

A Fairtrade stall is held on the last Sunday of the month at Christ Church, on the second Sunday of the month at Good Shepherd and also at special events. Sadly, this has not been possible since the coronavirus rules but we hope that one day it can start up again.

During 2019 there were sales of £1,400 at Christ Church and £1,020 at Good Shepherd; we had enough surplus to send a £120 donation from the two churches to this year's Christian Aid appeal to help boost the donation sent from both churches.

The Wolverhampton Fair Trade shop in town has now had to shut owing to the closure of the Darlington Street Methodist Church where it had its premises. The shop contents are now in storage awaiting the possibility of opening a new shop in the town centre when the pandemic is under control.
