### Covenant Service

God made a covenant with the people of Israel, calling them to be a holy nation, chosen to bear witness to his steadfast love by finding delight in the law. The covenant was renewed in Jesus Christ our Lord, in his life, work, death and resurrection. In him all people may be set free from sin and its power, and united in love and obedience. In this covenant God promises us new life in Christ. For our part we promise to live no longer for ourselves but for God.

We meet, therefore, as generations have met before us, to renew the covenant which bound them and binds us to God.

### Confession

Let us then seek forgiveness for the sin by which we have denied God's claim upon us.

As we come to the Lord at the start of this New Year, let us seek his grace to number our days, that we may apply our hearts to wisdom as we confess our sins in penitence and faith.

Father, when our worship has been more about us than about you,

*All* **Lord, have mercy.**

When our songs have ignored the pain of your broken body on earth.

*All* **Christ have mercy.**

When our services have been more of an escape for us, than good news for the poor,

*All* **Lord, have mercy.**

When we praise you with our lips, but deny you with our finances,

*All* **Christ, have mercy.**

When our instruments are louder than our cries for justice,

*All* **Lord, have mercy.**

When we fail to learn from the sacrificial worship of brothers and sisters across the world,

*All* **Christ, have mercy.**

May God, who suffered the death of his only Son for our sake, forgive us our sins, cleanse us by the blood of Christ, and fill us with his Holy Spirit, to lead lives of worship that bring his resurrection power to our broken world. **Amen.**

### Renewal of the Covenant

Eternal God

in your faithful and enduring love you call us to share in your gracious covenant in Jesus Christ.

In obedience we hear and accept your commands; in love we seek to do your perfect will; with joy we offer ourselves anew to you. We are no longer our own but yours.
