### Knitted cross

I used double knitting wool and 4mm (no. 8) needles for the cross but any oddments of wool can be used

Cast on 5

Knit 26 rows

Cast on 5 , knit to the end , cast on 5

Knit 7 rows

Cast off 5 , knit to the end

Cast off 5

Knit 7 rows

Cast off



I have ribbon and buttons to finish the crosses once they have been made.

If you could help, please let me know. I know how much the angels were appreciated; this would be such a meaningful way of showing our love for those we miss seeing at church at Easter.
