Please can you help with envelope delivery during Christian Aid Week? (Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May – Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May)

1. This year we will be able to deliver AND collect envelopes as usual, as long as the planned relaxation of the Coronavirus restrictions continue as scheduled.
2. We can also choose to just deliver envelopes, and trust that each household will make a contribution in ways explained on the envelope.
3. Or we can choose (individually) to designate our home to be an envelope drop-off location. This would probably work best if you delivered envelopes in the street where you live (providing it is in our catchment area).
