In your mercy, forgive us.

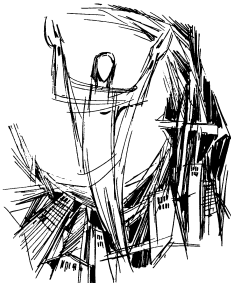

Lord, you are holy indeed, the source of all holiness;

PRAISE: The Easter Anthems
